DRIVING DIRECTIONS IF NEEDED

All Saints is on the corner of Ladner Trunk Road and Arthur Drive. If coming from Hwy 17, southbound towards the ferries you will turn right (west bound) on Ladner Trunk Rd. Follow Ladner Trunk Rd until you come to the intersection of Arthur Drive and Ladner Trunk Rd. The church is located on the southwest corner. Once you see the church turn left (onto Arthur Drive) and then make an immediate right into the driveway leading into the parking lot.
